

Creating links to articles found in the library databases.

1. The best way to create a link to an article found in through a library database is to start with the [Citation Linker tool](#). Located under the Find Articles from the [library homepage](#).

Have a citation?

Get It @ Kresge

You can enter the article details and find the **article full text** electronically, if available.

2. Click the Get-It@Kresge link and use the form to type in your citation information.

3. Click **Look Up** button after you have entered all the citation information. The Get-It Window will open. The system will search for your article in all databases Oakland has access to and provide you with a link to the full-text if it is available.

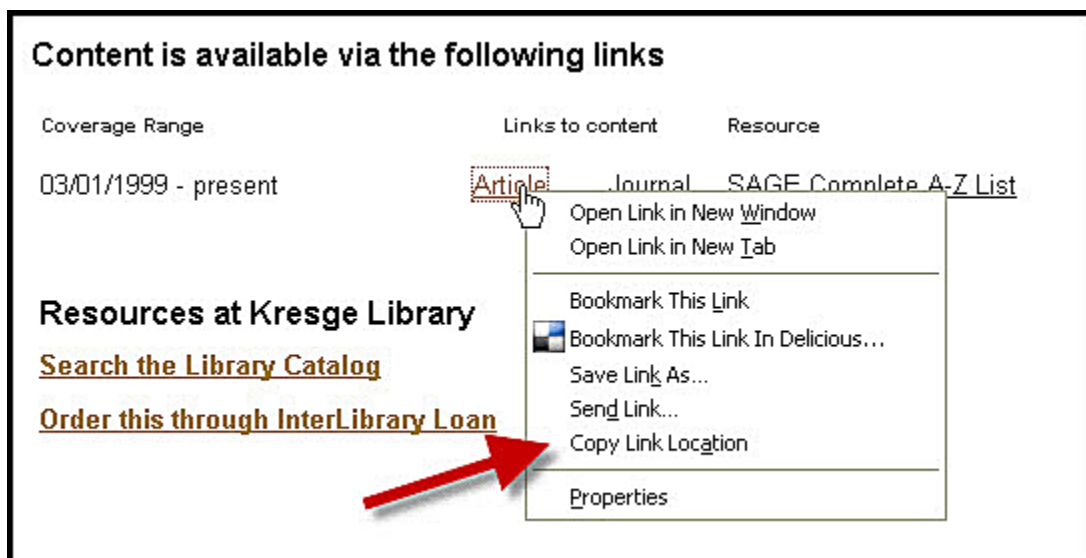
